Lichfield RAF Air Cadets announces Search and Rescue Mission

Due to the ever increasing number of cadets, the Lichfield 1206 (Mercian) Squadron are using all the training rooms at their base in Cherry Orchard and need to find new facilities. The Search and Rescue Mission was launched when the Squadron realised that with the planned intake in January 2013, cadet numbers would be approaching 60 and urgent action was needed.

Even with sports, fieldcraft and flying taking place offsite the training accommodation is stretched to capacity as running five concurrent streams of interactive training takes a significant amount of space.

Flight Lieutenant Chris Kelly, the commanding officer is appealing for local businesses, charities and organisations to help with the search and rescue mission. "We are actively looking for space that we could move into within the next month. Ideally it would be for a facility that could fit us all in or that we could use as additional classrooms on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. As the Squadron's success continues they are planning to move to two flights. This is makes excellent news for cadet career and promotion prospects as it creates another path for cadets to rise to the more senior ranks of Sergeant and Flight Sergeant. At the same time it creates further vacancies for uniformed and civilian volunteers and Flight Lieutenant Kelly is keen to recruit in the early part of 2013.
